To: Prospective Undergraduates and Parents:

At its January meeting the Cornell University Board of Trustees adopted the following schedule of tuition charges for students in the several undergraduate divisions. In addition, the Trustees approved increases in undergraduate housing charges of 3.5% and in food prices of about 8%. These increases were reluctantly made and became effective at the close of the Spring term 1973.

The University recognizes that these tuition and cost rises will increase the financial burden for some parents since in many cases scholarship aid cannot be raised automatically to offset the new charges. However, the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid will consider these cost increases when evaluating the need of financial aid candidates.

The new undergraduate tuition and fee schedule for 1973-74 is:
